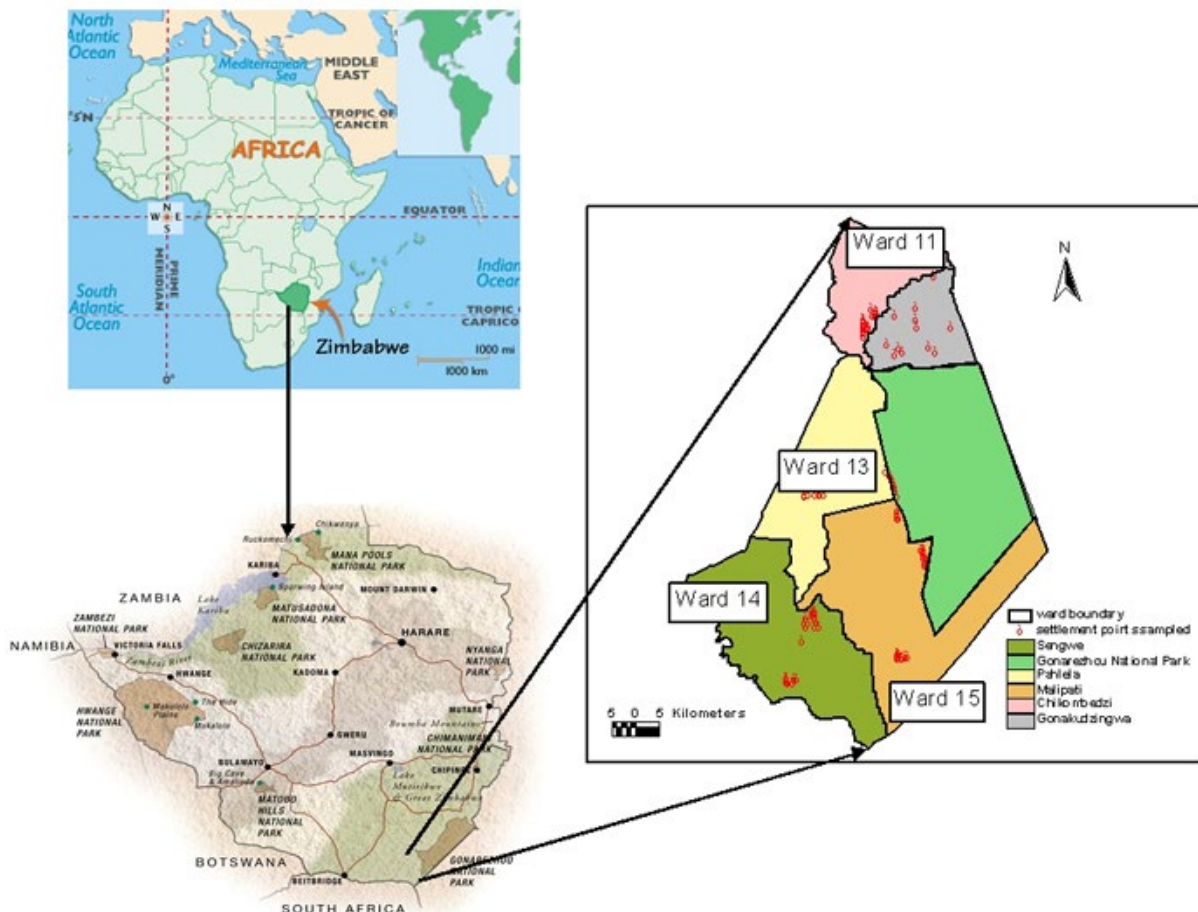




GONAREZHOU SAFARI AREAS SENGWÉ 1 AND 2 IN THE SOUTH EASTERN LOWVELD OF ZIMBABWE

The Gonarezhou Safari areas Sengwe 1 and 2 are hunting areas that are open and un-fenced areas adjoined to the Gonarezhou National and the Kruger National Park plus the Mozambique National Park, these are massive areas made up of different hunting blocks that form part of the Sengwe 1 and 2 Hunting concessions.

The Sengwe 1 and 2 TTL (Tribal Trust Land) hunting areas include Crooks Corner on the Zimbabwean side that is within in our concession and is a real hot spot for dagga boys and trophy elephant bulls. Sengwe is well known for top trophy quality elephant and buffalo plus hippo and crocodile that are also available plus the occasional eland and kudu bulls that are found in the Sengwe concessions although the real strength of the Sengwe areas is big game. There are people living in and around the Sengwe areas in a low population density scenario as there always has been since the days that Hemmingway and Bvenkye Barnard hunted here.

Also located on the Nuanetsi River to the South of Malipati another top concession in the southern Lowveld of Zimbabwe.



KWALA-KWALA / SENGWE 1

Located in the Southernmost tip of Zimbabwe on the Limpopo River that is the border between Kruger Park and Zimbabwe this magnificent location allows free roaming for animals between Kruger and the hunting concession, a truly beautiful place to hunt and can be described as a part of the Kruger Park.
